Will non-EU students qualify for a 18-month post-study work permit?

Yes, you can apply for the post-study work permit to look for a job that corresponds with your qualifications. You can apply for this permit as soon as you have passed your final exam.

What are the accommodation options?

Leipzig offers a range of high-quality, affordable housing options, with an average cost of around €600 per month (including bills). You can choose between modern off-campus student residences or private and shared apartments – all conveniently located within walking distance, or a short bike or tram ride to campus.

Are there any funding options?

A wide variety of scholarships is available. Additionally, EU students may qualify for tuition funding through options such as BrainCapital.

Can relevant work experience help if academic requirements are not met?

Yes, relevant professional experience within the industry will be considered.
